Election Information and Calendar

Monday, April 15, 2019	FIRST DAY to obtain and file a “Declaration of Candidacy” and a “Candidate Statement of Qualifications” at the Registrar of Voters’ Office.
Friday, May 3, 2019	LAST DAY to file a “Declaration of Candidacy” and “Candidate Statement of Qualifications” at the Registrar of Voters’ Office.
Monday, June 3, 2019	BALLOTS ARE MAILED: Official SJCERA Ballots and Candidate Statements of Qualifications are mailed to each eligible voter by the Registrar of Voters. (A duplicate ballot may be provided by the Registrar of Voters upon completion of a request form by the voting member. Request forms are available by calling 209-468-8945 or emailing registrar@sjgov.org.
Monday, June 17, 2019	BALLOTS ARE DUE: Last day to return the Official SJCERA Ballot. All ballots must be returned no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 17, 2019 to: Registrar of Voters’ Office, 44 N. San Joaquin St., Suite 350 Stockton, California 95202 All envelopes containing ballots must be signed by the voting member.
Tuesday, June 18, 2019	ELECTION DAY: The Registrar of Voters shall begin the Official Canvass of the SJCERA ballots and, upon completion, shall certify the results of the election to the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors.

The Declaration of Candidacy (Sponsors Certificate) and the Candidate Statement of Qualification forms will be issued by the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters in Suite 350 of the County Administration Building located at 44 N. San Joaquin St., Stockton, CA 95202.

Candidates must be SAFETY MEMBERS of the San Joaquin County Employees’ Retirement Association. Deferred and retired members are not eligible. Candidates must submit a properly completed Sponsors Certificate. The Registrar of Voters shall certify the number of qualified sponsors. The Certificate must contain no less than 15 qualified signatures. The candidate may not submit more than 25 signatures. Candidates are encouraged to submit a Candidate Statement of Qualifications.

The top vote-getter in the election for SAFETY MEMBER will be the Seventh Member of the Board of Retirement, and shall be referred to as the Seventh Member or Alternate Seventh Member, depending on the composition of the Board. This status will be determined after the top vote-getter is certified.
