We are confident that under her guidance, SJCERA will continue to thrive and fulfill its commitment to our valued members."

Ostrander expressed her enthusiasm and gratitude for the opportunity, stating, "I am honored to join SJCERA as its next CEO and contribute to the financial security and well-being of public employees. I look forward to working closely with SJCERA's talented team and, together, SJCERA will become even stronger."
