FRIDAY, MAY 10	Last day to file a Declaration of Candidacy, Certificate of Sponsorship, and Candidate Statement of Qualifications with the Registrar of Voters' Office.
MONDAY, MAY 20	Final Voter Eligibility List: The Chief Executive Officer shall provide the Registrar of Voters' Office with a Final Voter Eligibility List.
MONDAY, JUNE 3	Ballots are Mailed: Official SJCERA Ballots and Candidate Statements of Qualifications are mailed to each eligible voter by the Registrar of Voters' Office. A duplicate ballot will be provided by the Registrar of Voters' Office upon submission of a request form.
