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3. San Joaquin County Employees' Retirement Association (SJCERA) is governed under the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937 (the '37 Act), which is set forth at section 31450, et seq., of the Government Code and was properly joined as a party to the Petitioner and Respondent's dissolution of marriage action pursuant to sections 2060 through 2065 of the Family Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 1. This Order is entered pursuant to the Family Code.
- 2. [Respondent or Petitioner] ("Member") and [Respondent or Petitioner] ("Nonmember") have acquired a community interest in the Member's monthly retirement benefits attributable to periods of service in SJCERA from the Date of Marriage up to the Date of Separation or Date of Retirement, whichever occurred first.
- 3. The Member is currently receiving from SJCERA retirement benefits of \$

Upon the dissolution of the marriage, the Nonmember ceases to qualify for unmodified survivor benefits pursuant to section 31760.1 of the Government Code.
- 4. <u>Calculation of Nonmember's Interest</u>. The Court allocates and awards to the Nonmember an interest in any and all of the Member's retirement benefits calculated as follows: 50% of the monthly retirement benefits attributable to the Member's service in SJCERA during the period from the Date of Marriage up to the Date of Separation, or date of retirement, whichever occurred first, as the Nonmember's sole and separate property.

[Note that if the Member is currently receiving a non-service connected disability retirement or service connected disability retirement, add the following language: As the Member is currently receiving a disability retirement benefit as specified in paragraph 3 above, at the time when the Member becomes first eligible for a service retirement, the Retirement Administrator of SJCERA shall designate that portion of the disability benefit which is attributable to a service retirement and allocate that portion of the benefit as specified in this section. The total combined benefit payments to both the Member and Non-Member shall not exceed the amount that would otherwise be paid to the member alone.] All retirement benefits which are not awarded to the Nonmember pursuant to this Order shall be the Member's sole and separate property.

- 5. <u>Commencement of Benefits to the Nonmember</u>. The Nonmember shall commence to receive the Nonmember's monthly benefits by separate warrant directly from SJCERA as soon as administratively practicable following the date the Administrator receives this Order.
- 6. Benefits payable at Member's Death. The Member shall be responsible for filing a Designation of Beneficiary form with SJCERA. Upon the Member's death, SJCERA shall continue to pay to the Nonmember the Nonmember's monthly benefit until the death of the Nonmember. Upon the Member's death, SJCERA shall pay by separate warrant directly to the beneficiary designated by the Member, the balance of any accumulated retirement contributions and interest remaining in the Member's account, less the amount attributable to any payments to the Nonmember pursuant to this Order, and any other benefits payable to that designated beneficiary, including but not limited to the any applicable death benefit. If the Member designates Member's minor children as beneficiary, then monthly survivor benefits may be payable pursuant to section 31760.1 of the Government Code.
- 7. <u>Benefits Payable at Nonmember's Death</u>. The Nonmember shall be responsible for filing a Designation of Beneficiary form with SJCERA. If benefits are still

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1	payable to the Member at the time of the Nonmember's death, SJCERA shall continue				
2	to pay the Nonmember's monthly benefit by separate warrant directly to the beneficiary

- 13. The Member and the Nonmember shall sign all forms, letters and other documents as required to effect the distribution(s) described herein and the intent of this Order.
- 14. The Nonmember, the Nonmember's agents and attorneys are authorized to receive information concerning the Member's benefits as may be needed to establish the Nonmember's account.
- 15. It is further ORDERED that the Member shall act as constructive trustee of any benefits assigned to the Nonmember under this Order which may be paid to or received by the Member. The Member, as trustee, shall promptly pay or transmit any such benefits to the Nonmember at the Nonmember's last known address. It is also ORDERED that the Nonmember shall act as constructive trustee of any benefits assigned to the Member under this Order which may be paid to or received by the Nonmember. The Nonmember, as trustee, shall promptly pay or transmit any such benefits to the Member at the Member's last known address.
- 16. This Order shall be administered and interpreted in conformity with the '37 Act and the Bylaws of SJCERA and other applicable law. If the '37 Act and/or the Bylaws of SJCERA are amended, then Member and the Nonmember shall immediately take the steps necessary to amend this Order to comply with any such amendments, changes and/or modifications, or, if permissible under any such change, amendment, or modification to the '37 Act and the Bylaws of SJCERA, the Administrator of SJCERA may treat this Order as acceptable. The Member and the Nonmember shall be

responsible for any of the costs and/or expenses associated with such amendment to this order.

- 17. The Member, the Nonmember, and the court intend that this Order meet all requirements of a domestic relations order under the '37 Act and the Bylaws of SJCERA and other laws of the State of California, and the Court shall reserve jurisdiction to modify this Order and to resolve any disputes that may arise among the parties and the Administrator of SJCERA concerning benefit payments or any other aspect of this Order. If any portion of this Order is rendered invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the Court reserves jurisdiction to make an appropriate adjustment to effectuate the intent of the parties. Any future fees, taxes, and/or penalties will be assessed against the parties who then have an interest payable from SJCERA.
- 18. This Stipulation and Order shall not expand the contractual or statutory obligations, whether substantive or procedural, of San Joaquin County or the San Joaquin County Employees' Retirement Association with respect to paying the above benefits.
